

DCUSH Timeline Activity (6th Period)

Instructions: We will build a timeline that will examine the events that lead to & through the Revolutionary War. We want to examine the actions of the British, Americans, and the French during the period 1754-1783. We will divide into 3 groups. Each group will be responsible for examining the actions of one of these 3 nationalities. Each group will use a different color of notecard to annotate events. Group 3 will also create the timeline on a long sheet of paper, with 1754 as the 1st event & 1783 as the last event.
