Paragraph 1: Brief Overview of Reading

- Title of what you read
- Title of larger work, if any
- Author
- Time Period
- Location
- Who was the intended audience?
- Why did the author write the book?
- Briefly describe what the reading is about

*Single space entire paper,
use an easily read font of 12.*

Paragraph 2: Specifics from the Reading

- Relate some of the incidents or events in the reading
- Briefly discuss each

Paragraph 3: Your Reaction to the Reading

- What did you think about the reading?
- How does it compare to what we have studied or read previously?
- How does it connect to what we have been studying?
- Brief conclusion

Remember to cover: 5 W's & Me:

- Who
 - Who wrote it?
 - Who is it written about?
 - Who is the intended audience?
- What
 - What was the author writing about?
- When
 - When was it written?
 - When were the events described (if different)?
- Where
 - Where did the event or action take place?
- Why
 - Why did the author write the book or passage?
- Your reaction
 - What was your reaction to the reading?
 - Be sure to relate to what we are studying

No more than one typed page. If you do this correctly, you will take ¾ to 1 page to tell your story. This writing is all about you thinking about what you read, the people who wrote it. & the time in which it was written..
